

Dr Ilias G. Bissias, Editor-in-Chief Naftika Chronika

Ilias G. Bissias is an Attorney at law, Editor in Chief of the award-winning Greek Shipping Magazine Naftika Chronika (published since 1931) and Executive Director of the educational platform <a href="Isalos.net">Isalos.net</a>. He is also currently the Director of Strategy and Policy of the Hellenic Marine Equipment Manufacturers and Exporters (HEMEXPO). In the past he has worked for the European Commission (1999-2002) and was a legal correspondent for Greece in the areas of air transport law and policy.

Dr. Bissias holds a Bachelor and Master's Degree in Law from the University of London (LSE) and a PhD in Maritime Policy from the University of the Aegean. Since 2014 he is part time and adjunct lecturer at Alba Graduate Business School and at the University of the Aegean in Chios, Greece teaching International Shipping Policy, Strategic Management in Shipping and Corporate Communications.
