The Establishment is based in Rome, where she lives with her family.

A graduate of the École Centrale, Éléonore Tramus has extensive professional experience in the fields of engineering and aeronautics.

After various experiences at SNECMA (SAFRAN Aircraft Engines), Éléonore joined the Group in 2010 at Air France Industries, as Head of Engineering for the medium-haul fleet. She then joined the Engines Engineering & Maintenance division of the Air France-KLM Group, notably as Business Development Director for the repair of engine parts (Boeing 777, Airbus 320).

In 2016, she was appointed Director of Air France's network planning for Asia, India, the Middle East and the Gulf.

In 2019, she held the position of Director of Global Agency Sales (Global Trades) for Air France-KLM for three years.
